TIPS FOR A BETTER PENMANSHIP

Handwriting is an important development skill and your handwriting says a lot about you.

- ✚ Get a great grasp
- ✚ Tripod grip (pinch the pencil with your thumb and index finger and support it with your middle finger)
- ✚ Your grip should be light yet supportive
- ✚ Lower the pressure
- ✚ Slow down. Take frequent breaks
- ✚ Let the lines be your guide
- ✚ Use lined paper to keep your writing aligned
- ✚ Use proper tools for writing
- ✚ Make a quick movement of fingers
- ✚ Retrain your wrist and arm
- ✚ Check your posture
- ✚ Practise whenever you can.
