- ❖ Training to students through Mock Interviews : 30.01.2020 (Thursday)

THE PROCEDURE

FOR KG to II

- ❖ Each student will take 5 questions.
- ❖ Prizes for those who answer a minimum of 3 questions.

FOR III to VI

- ❖ Each student will take 10 questions.
- ❖ Prizes for those who answer a minimum of 6 questions .

FOR VII TO IX

- ❖ 3 topics will be given on the spot.
- ❖ Each student should pick any one topic and speak.
- ❖ Duration is minimum one minute and maximum three minutes.
- ❖ Prizes for those who score 6 out of 10 marks (VII & VIII) and 7 out of 10 (IX).



DRESS CODE FOR 'HOW I SPEAK' INTERVIEW

Parents are requested to send the students dressed up for the 'How I Speak' on Friday as follows.

- ❖ The questions and the topics of the talk have been obtained by the school management from well known career experts.
- ❖ The questions and the topics will not be shared with level Principals / VPs / Teachers / Students beforehand.
- ❖ Parents need not train the students at home.

- ❖ In case some students don't do well, we will develop such abilities in them in due course.
- ❖ All students in Everwin will continue to be trained in employable skills and entrepreneurial abilities through CET, the daily talk by our Senior Principal, language fluency camps, reading and writing skill camps and more.



TIPS FOR CHILDREN TO FACE INTERVIEW

1. Get a good night's sleep before the interview.
2. Don't worry if you are nervous – most students are.
3. Dress to impress. Wear wrinkle – free clothing and avoid garments with stylish holes or casual wears.
4. Be prepared to answer questions. Explain your answer and be calm and articulate but don't over explain.
5. Make sure you know about your school, class and teachers. The more research the better.
6. Make sure you have a firm handshake and always use eye contact.
7. Good posture makes a strong impression. So, sit up tall and don't slouch, fidget, bite your nails, pull your hair or pick your nose.
8. Call the interviewer Sir and Madam.
9. Understand the questions before you answer.
10. Always be polite, professional and attentive during your interview.
